- *Pick 2 books from your Card to write a book review about and submit the reviews with your Card.*

### How do I submit my completed challenge card?

Drop off your *completed* Card and book reviews at the Library, or place in a sealed envelope in any of NVPL's book drops. Or you may fill out the online Summer Reading Challenge form. All submissions for prizes must be received by **5 pm** on Saturday, August 7.

### What if I need suggestions for books to read?

Ask a North Valley Public Library librarian for ideas crafted just for you. Talk to your friends or family. Try the website "What Should I Read Next?" or see the book lists included in your Summer Reading Challenge packet.

### What can I win and how?

For every 5 squares you fill in, you'll receive a prize; fill in 8 or more and get entered to win a Grand Prize. This year's Grand Prizes include \$25 gift cards and a Stevensville Pool Season Pass for 2022. Pick up your prizes throughout or at the end of the summer. *Get a bonus grand prize entry for taking a selfie with your favorite book at the Library and/or creating a Book Merge - grab a friend and a camera, along with your favorite book or magazine then blend yourself with the cover.
