- Must be acceptable viewing content for all ages. In an effort to have a welcoming, stress free environment for all, the library will not display nudity, blood, gore, racist images, or partisan political work.
- No photographs or computer generated art accepted for this exhibit.
- The Library reserves the right to reject submissions.
- Works that are of high value, fragile in nature or in a frame of questionable durability may be rejected.
- Must be able to pick up art between March 1 - March 5.

Friday, January 28 at 6:30-7:30 pm is the art opening and voting. One vote per category per person.
